#DelranFeeds Food Delivery Solicits Volunteers

The Delran Township Board of Education delivered 4,666 meals to families in Delran Township on Wednesday. We are planning in advance should the operations and/or food services joint teams become unable to serve due to contracting Coronavirus.

The Coronavirus Task Force convened today to begin to draft multiple contingency plans. We have drafted a "Plan B" and "Plan C." Let's hope we need neither plan.

Plan B solicits volunteers to serve in any phase of the #DelranFeeds initiative. On a purely volunteer basis, the Coronavirus Task Force would like to organize community volunteers to be available to serve in our **#DelranFeeds** initiative should the need arise.

20 Day Distance Learning Plan

Our Distance Learning Plan kicked off today. We expect K-5 students to work through instructional activities. All students in Grade 6 - Grade 12 are to begin work in their courses through the Google Classroom interface.

technological successes and challenges (Grade 6 through Grade 12) **and a technological/network availability survey (Pre-K through Grade 5).**


Food Distribution
