 - Critical Area of Operation #2: Classroom, Testing and Therapy Rooms - Appendix B
Change the following sections to reflect up to 3 feet of distancing between students in classroom settings:

Add section D: All tents and outdoor spaces will follow identical cleaning protocols as cafeterias and all- purpose rooms

 - Critical Area of Operation #8: Meals
Section 12
Modify to reflect the following: In DIS and Millbridge utilize classrooms, cafeteria, all purpose room and outdoor tents to eat breakfast and lunch.

Section 13B
Modify to reflect the following: DMS and DHS will make use of the gym and outdoor tents to allow students to eat in a properly spaced location outside of the cafeteria.

New Section, 9D: Implement full day of instruction by merging Rancocas and Delaware cohorts into one provided recommendations from Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and New Jersey Department of Health can be met to the maximum extent possible.

New Section, 9E: If necessary, due to public health factors, implement a Single Session schedule, without Lunch, while continuing with one merged cohort at the discretion of the Superintendent in consultation with the Burlington County Department of Health and Delran Township Board of Education.

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve the implementation of merging the hybrid Delaware and Rancocas Cohorts into one cohort for in person, full day instruction at Delran High School on April 19, 2021 or a date to be determined by the Superintendent of Schools in consultation with the New Jersey Department of Health COVID-19 Activity Level Report; Burlington County Department of Health; and Delran Township Board of Education.
